II. Treasurer's Report: Total: \$14,320.48. Adrienne Trent will create a new sub-account for the Technology Fund. As all money goes into the General Fund, we will need to vote on the amount to go into the Technology Fund. III. Old Business:

Juice N Java: Donated \$125 from Roosevelt Night Out.

Color Run: \$2,234.00 raised but no receipts have been submitted to date. These funds will go into the Technology Fund. A discussion was held about an incident where a parent volunteer may have given a female student a bag of color who stated that she dropped the bag in the restroom and the color spilled. The restroom had to be shut down to be cleaned. Mrs. Humphrey stated that she does not want to add more work for the custodian(s) and would like to work together to make sure this doesn't happen in the future. Adrienne Trent stated that she would like the parent volunteer mentioned above to confirm that he did indeed give the female student the color. Cristina Vigne stated that she wants to make sure that the Minutes will be written objectively regarding this incident and noted how easy it would be to "be nice and give a child a packet of color. KeriAnn Turk suggested that all color in the prize packets needs to stay at home. Mrs. Humphrey stated that she will always seek teacher input for all events as they impact their day.

Date Changes: Mrs. Humphrey stated that Field Day will now be on May 18, 2018, and the Recognition Program will take place on May 17, 2018.

Incident at Fun Town: It was noted that a parent fell at Fun Town and broke her leg. BPS Risk Management is looking into this situation. Adrienne Trent noted that this is why PTO has insurance. Mrs. Humphrey stated that she will screen all information disseminated for all events to make sure it says "Roosevelt PTO" and not "Roosevelt."

PTO Website Renewal: The PTO website will be up for renewal soon. It costs \$60.00 for a random domain name and \$120.00 to keep Roosevelt PTO domain name. After a discussion, Tabitha Braddock asked that a motion be made to pay the \$120.00 to keep our current domain name. 1st = Mary Demore, 2nd = Cristina Vigne.
